Childbirth call instructions



Childbirth usually starts between 37 and 42 weeks.
These call instructions apply to women who are in weeks 37 - 42 of their pregnancy.



Always call if you are less than 37 weeks pregnant and experience loss of amniotic fluid, cramps, contractions or blood loss.

Don't call (normal)



- irregular contractions
- short contractions
- time between contractions is more than five minutes

Contractions

Call



2 uur

First pregnancy:

- 1–2 hours of regular contractions every 3 to 4 minutes
- which last around 1 minute



1 uur

Second pregnancy or more:

- 1 hour of regular contractions
- every 5 minutes
- which last nearly 1 minute



- watery discharge
- urinary incontinence

Loss of fluid and colour of the water



- you suspect your water has broken (continuous/intermittent loss of fluid, clear, colourless or light pink in colour)
- take note of the colour of the amniotic fluid (green/brown)



- a wipe of blood

Blood loss



- bright red blood loss, more than a wipe
