


Pregnancy call instructions

Don't call (normal)	One or more of the following symptoms after 20 weeks of pregnancy	Call
 <p>Brown discharge. Discuss this at the consultation.</p>	Blood loss	 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• headache• seeing stars/light flashes• vomiting• feeling of tightness or pain around your upper abdomen• sudden, excessive water retention• tingling fingers
 <p>The baby is moving as normal</p>	The baby's movement after 28 weeks	 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• if you feel less movement than normal, lie on your left side• contact us if you have been lying on your left side for 2 hours and have felt fewer than 10 movements or if the movements feel weak to you• <i>contact us immediately if you are between 24 and 28 weeks of pregnancy and are unsure about the number of movements</i>
 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• urinary incontinence• more or thinner discharge than normal	Loss of fluid	 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• continuously wet underwear• intermittent fluid loss• loss of green/brown fluid

Don't call (normal)



- hard abdomen during physical exertion
- hard abdomen when the baby moves
- hard abdomen, no pain
- irregular

Hard abdomen/ cramps



- worsening of cramps
- regularity in the hard abdomen/
cramps, e.g., once every five minutes
- pain

- always call if you are anxious or concerned
- if the information you have received is unclear
